But for some reason the war years also brought much visitation. Summer of 1943 was particularly busy here,

as an article in The Catskill Mountain News reported, Fleischmanns was "full."

The post-war economy boomed, and a holiday season ad in 1950 showed many active businesses here in Fleischmanns.

This was also the time when Belleayre Ski Center opened, turning what had been a summer-only resort into more of a year-round destination. There had been limited skiing in the area for several decades, but New York State's investment in Belleayre raised it to a much higher level.

We'll continue to look for ways to contribute to the community going forward.

Some of us are making face masks for Basset Memorial Hospital, others are making food deliveries for the Food Pantry, and others are making monetary donations to organization such as Mark Project or the Food Pantry of Margaretville.
